- ◆ let the school know about concerns or problems that may affect my child's work or behaviour;
- ◆ ensure the school uniform is provided and that my child has the proper equipment;
- ◆ support the school's homework policy, including providing time and space for homework;
- ◆ read the regular newsletter, and sign the School Diary*;
- ◆ attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress.

The School aims to:

- ◆ make clear the school's Aims and Values;
- ◆ praise good effort and good work;
- ◆ contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality, uniform or equipment*;
- ◆ let parents know about concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour;
- ◆ set and respond to homework, and provide facilities for children to do homework in school;
- ◆ keep parents informed about school activities through the weekly newsletter;
- ◆ provide assessments and an annual report;
- ◆ arrange Parents' Evenings to discuss progress.
